### Dry Farming Institute

Eliza Mason, Holly Crosson and Nate Johnson discuss how there will be an upcoming talk at the July board meeting about dry farming. Eliza Mason is on the board for the Dry Farming Institute, and Nate Johnson has been a part of the Dry Farming Collaborative for the past 7 years or so.
